GACA Regulation Circular No. R-23-2012

TO: SERVICE PROVIDERS, GACA CERTIFICATE HOLDERS
AND OPERATORS OF SAUDI ARABIAN REGISTERED
AIRCRAFT

SUBJECT: Importing Aviation Products to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

In accordance with the Civil Aviation Act of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) as approved by the Council of Ministers Resolution No. 185 dated 17/07/1426H and issued by the Royal Decree No. M/44 dated 18/07/1426H (23/08/2005G), and based on the authority granted in Article 179 of the Act, The following Regulations are issued under the authority of the President of General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA), as a duly delegated representative of the GACA Board of Directors, in accordance with Order No.T-41, dated 30/12/1429H (28/12/2008G).

The GACA currently accepts aircraft, engines and propellers type certificated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) of the United States of America for importation into the Kingdom. Type certificates from other civil aviation authorities will have to be validated by the GACA before importation into the Kingdom.

Aircraft that are not eligible for type certificates, such as light-sport category aircraft, gliders and balloons, will be accepted for importation subject to the rules and regulations of the concerned Saudi Arabian government agencies and meeting the guidelines and policies established by the Vice President, GACA Safety and Economic Regulation.

Importation of aviation products manufactured in countries included in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia trade ban list will not be allowed.
