Public Tender for Obtaining a National Non-Scheduled Air Carrier (Charter) License

To drive growth in Saudi Arabia's aviation sector and meet ambitious national targets, the General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA) is offering a public tender for a National Non-Scheduled Air Carrier (Charter) License. This initiative aims to boost competitiveness, improve traveler services, and contribute to the National Aviation Strategy's goals of serving 330 million passengers and connecting to over 250 international destinations by 2030.

Interested parties must submit an official letter to the General Authority of Civil Aviation via email at CHRFP@gaca.gov.sa to request the tender documents (RFP) and specifications. The letter must include the applicant's information and contact details.

- The submission period begins from the date of this announcement, starting from today April 13, 2025, The deadline for receiving proposals is Wednesday, May 21, 2025, from 10:00 AM to 15:00 PM.
- Bids must be submitted in accordance with the tender documents, in an official letter, placed in a sealed and stamped envelope addressed to the Office of the Executive Vice President for the Economic Policy and Logistics Services Sector at the General Authority of Civil Aviation (P.O. Box 8691, Riyadh 13443, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia).
- A password-protected electronic copy must also be emailed to CHRFP@gaca.gov.sa addressed to the Economic Policy and Logistics Services Sector, and the password must be sent on the day of the bid opening to the same email.
- Inquiries will be accepted during the bid submission period via CHRFP@gaca.gov.sa, until 12:00 PM on Thursday, May 8, 2025.
- All responses will be shared with all applicants. No inquiries will be accepted through any other means, and no responses will be given to questions that could influence the tender process or disclose any confidential information.
- The opening of the bids will take place on Thursday, May 22, 2025, and all applicants will be invited to attend and witness the documentation of the submitted proposals.
- In case of any discrepancy between the hard copy and the electronic version of the proposal, the applicant will be immediately disqualified.
- No proposals will be accepted after the submission deadline.
