GACA Regulation Circular No. R-25-2012

TO: SERVICE PROVIDERS, GACA CERTIFICATE HOLDERS AND OPERATORS OF SAUDI ARABIAN REGISTERED AIRCRAFT

SUBJECT: Importation, Certification and Operational Requirements for

Light Sport Aircraft.

In accordance with the Civil Aviation Law of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) as approved by the Council of Ministers Resolution No. 185 dated 17/07/1426H and issued by the Royal Decree No. M/44 dated 18/07/1426H (23/08/2005G), and based on the authority granted in Article 179 of the Law, the following Regulations are issued under the authority of the President of General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA), as a duly delegated representative of the GACA Board of Directors, in accordance with Order No.T-41, dated 30/12/1429H (28/12/2008G).

The GACA is adopting the policy detailed in the United States Federal Aviation Administration Order # 8130.2G, as revised, for airworthiness certification of Light Sport Aircraft (LSA). GACA airworthiness certification forms must be used and are available in the related GACA Airworthiness Guides and GACA official website.

Aircraft that are not eligible for type certificates, such as light sport aircraft, will be accepted for importation subject to the rules and regulations of the concerned Saudi Arabian government agencies and meeting the regulation issued by GACA applicable to this type of aircraft.
