## GACA Regulation Circular No. R-24-2012

TO: SERVICE PROVIDERS, GACA CERTIFICATE HOLDERS AND OPERATORS OF SAUDI ARABIAN REGISTERED AIRCRAFT

SUBJECT: Signs and Placards Language Requirements

In accordance with the Civil Aviation Law of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) as approved by the Council of Ministers Resolution No. 185 dated 17/07/1426H and issued by the Royal Decree No. M/44 dated 18/07/1426H (23/08/2005G), and based on the authority granted in Article 179 of the Law, the following Regulations are issued under the authority of the President of General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA), as a duly delegated representative of the GACA Board of Directors, in accordance with Order No.T-41, dated 30/12/1429H (28/12/2008G).

All aircraft authorized to operate for public transportation under GACA/FAR Part 121 or Part 135 must have all exit signs, placards, safety information sheets and any other safety related instructions in both English and Arabic languages. This includes all leased aircraft listed in the air operators' Operations Specifications.
