Background:

New Zealand authorities have approved new procedures for travelers to New Zealand or wishing to pass through its airports, the so-called electronic system for travel authorization to New Zealand (NZeTA), which will be implemented in early October 2019.

Instructions:

- Ensure that travelers to the Republic of New Zealand obtain a visa according to the following procedures:
 - 1- Entering some personal information and data at least 72 hours before traveling through the website (<http://nzeta.immigration.gov.nz/>) or smart devices via the application (NZeTA).
 2. When applying for this (compulsory) service, New Zealand authorities may request additional information or apply for a visa through the New Zealand Embassy in Riyadh.
 3. This procedure does not apply to persons with regular visas (student or work visa), etc.
 4. This permit shall remain valid for two years from the date of issue and for more than one visit.
 5. The traveler must disclose the correct information including criminal record or intention to receive medical treatment in New Zealand.
 - 6 - Visa application fees through smart devices (NZ \$ 9) or through the website (NZ \$ 12), in addition to fees of (NZ \$ 35) tourism allowance and protection for visitors.
